Hot Weather is Here.... And the snakes are out!!!

- *Be aware of your surroundings.
- *Be cautious in tall grass and watch where you step. Walk in areas where the ground is clear so you can see where you step.
- *Don't reach blindly into rock cracks, wood piles, animal burrows, or under bushes or piles of leaves. Some snakes use camouflage to hide in plain sight.

Most snake bites occur when a snake is accidentally stepped on, surprised, or harassed. Many bites occur when a person tries to get a closer look or tries to kill the snake. Just leave snakes alone! If you encounter a snake, stay calm and freeze in place; the snake will often move away. If the snake doesn't move, then you should slowly walk away, keeping it as far away as possible. Snakes are not aggressive and don't chase people. Snakes would rather escape from noise and commotion or remain quiet and hidden.

G-2.0301 Ruling Elder Defined

As there were in Old Testament times, elders for the government of the people, so the New Testament church provided persons with particular gifts to share in discernment of God's Spirit and governance of God's people. Accordingly, congregations should elect persons of wisdom and maturity of faith, having demonstrated skills in leadership and being compassionate in spirit. Ruling elders are so named not because they "lord it over" the congregation (Matt. 20:25), but because they are chosen by the congregation to discern and measure its fidelity to the Word of God, and to strengthen and nurture its faith and life.

Ruling elders, together with ministers of the Word and Sacrament (Pastor), exercise leadership, government, spiritual discernment, and discipline and have responsibilities for the life of a congregation as well as the whole church, including ecumenical relationships. When elected by the congregation, they shall serve faithfully as members of the session. When elected as commissioners to higher councils, ruling elders participate and vote with the same authority as ministers of the Word and Sacrament, and they are eligible for any office.
