

Esther Chapter 4:1, 4-8, 10-17

1 When Mordecai learned all that had happened, he tore his clothes and put on sackcloth and ashes.

- 4 So Esther's maids and eunuchs came and told her, and the queen was deeply distressed. 5 Then Esther called Hathach, (Hay-tak) one of the king's eunuchs whom he had appointed to attend her, and she gave him a command concerning Mordecai, to learn what and why this was. 6 So Hathach went out to Mordecai... 7 And Mordecai told him all that had happened, and the sum of money that Haman (Hay-muhn) had promised to pay to the king's treasuries to destroy the Jews. 8 He also gave him a copy of the written decree, so that he might show it to Esther and that he might command her to go in to the king to make supplication to the King and plead before him for her people.
- 10 Then Esther spoke to Hathach, and gave he gave him a message for Mordecai: 11 "All the king's servants and the people of the king's provinces know that if a man or woman goes into the inner court to the king, who has not been called, *he has* but one law: put *all* to death, except the one to whom the king holds out the golden scepter, that he may live. Yet I myself have not been called

to go in to the king these thirty days." **12** So Hathach told Mordecai Esther's words.

- **13** And Mordecai told him to answer Esther saying: "Do not think in your heart that you will escape in the king's palace any more than all the other Jews. **14** For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows perhaps you have come to the kingdom **for such a time as this?"**
- **15** Then Esther told Hathach to reply to Mordecai: saying **16** "Go, gather all the Jews who are present in Shushan,(**shoe-shon**) and fast for me; neither eat nor drink for three days, night or day. My maids and I will fast likewise. And so I will go to the king, which *is* against the law; and if I perish, I perish!"

17 So Mordecai went his way and did according to all that Esther commanded him.
