Scripture Reading: Esther 2:1-13, 16-18

2 After these things, when the wrath of King Ahasuerus (A-hah-sur-us) he remembered Vashti, what she had done, and what had been decreed against her. 2 Then the king's servants who attended him said: "Let beautiful young virgins be sought for the king; 3...And let beauty preparations be given them. 4 Then let the young woman who pleases the king be queen instead of Vashti." This thing pleased the king, and he did so.

**5** In Shushan the citadel there was a certain Jew whose name *was* Mordecai the son of Jair, the son of Shimei, the son of Kish, a Benjamite. **6** *Kish* had been carried away from Jerusalem with the captives who had been captured with Jeconiah king of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away. **7** And *Mordecai* had brought up Hadassah, that *is*, Esther, his uncle's daughter, for she had neither father nor mother. The young woman *was* lovely and beautiful. When her father and mother died, Mordecai took her as his own daughter.

**8** So it was, when the king's command and decree were heard, and when many young women were gathered at Shushan the citadel, *under* the custody of Hegai,

that Esther also was taken to the king's palace. **9** Now the young woman pleased him, and she obtained his favor; so he readily gave beauty preparations to her, besides her allowance. Then seven choice maidservants were provided for Esther from the king's palace, and he moved her and her maidservants to the best *place* in the house of the women.

- **10** Esther had not revealed her people or family, for Mordecai had told her not to reveal *it.* **11** And every day Mordecai paced in front of the court of the women's quarters, to learn of Esther's welfare and what was happening to her.
- **12** Each young woman's turn came to go in to King Ahasuerus (**A-hah-sur-us**) she had completed twelve months' preparation, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with perfumes and preparations for beautifying women.
- **13** ...And Esther obtained favor in the sight of all who saw her. **16** So Esther was taken to King Ahasuerus, into his royal palace, in the tenth month, which *is* the month of Tebeth, in the seventh year of his reign. **17** The king loved Esther more than all the *other* women, and she obtained grace and favor in his sight more than all the virgins; so he set the royal crown upon her head and made her queen instead of Vashti. **18** Then the king made a great feast, the Feast of Esther, for all his officials and servants; and he proclaimed a holiday in the provinces and gave gifts according to the generosity of a king.
